



Iconic 'Sholay' returns to Sydney screens

The Indian Film Festival of Sydney (IFFS) has announced that restored version of 'Sholay' will be its centrepiece film this October. It is presented by the team behind the Indian Film Festival of Melbourne. The festival is set to run from October 9 to October 11 and aims to celebrate Indian cinema across three days. The restoring of 'Sholay' included recovering original material and long-lost scenes, resulting in a 4K version with the original ending. 'Sholay', widely regarded as one of the most iconic films in Indian cinema, underwent an extensive restoration process. The completed 4K restoration revives film's visual and audio quality and returns it to its original 70mm format. This marks the first time in decades that audiences will have the chance to see 'Sholay' as it was originally conceived.
